## Welcome to The Sewickley Eye Group.

You have been scheduled for an appointment next week. In this ever changing world of insurance requirements, we find it necessary to ask you to update your records to meet with current regulations. We thought it would be more convenient for you to do this in the comfort of your own home. Even if you were recently in the office or have been coming to our office for several years, we are required to have current personal and medical information in your files.

Would you, therefore, take a few minutes to complete the patient information and past medical history forms and sign the payment and fax authorization form and bring them with you on your next appointment?

If you are covered by insurance, please sign the form on the reverse side of the patient information sheet in the appropriate places and bring it and your insurance card(s) with you the day of your appointment as well as a current photo ID. Insurance co-pays and payment of non-covered services are due at check-in. Also, if you require a referral, please be sure to call your primary care physician at least five (5) working days prior to your appointment.

For many of our exams, dilating drops are instilled to give us a better view into the back of your eyes. While these drops don't usually affect your distance vision significantly, they may affect your driving somewhat by making you more light sensitive. Consider bringing a driver with you to the exam, if possible. We will be happy to give you sunglasses you can use to reduce the light sensitivity and, of course, you are invited to remain in our office until you feel comfortable with your vision.
